

Marion County Children's Fund

The Marion County Children's Fund is a non-profit organization whose purpose is serving children in foster care with the Tennessee Department of Children's Services as well as other needy children in the community.

Foster children are given a monetary gift for their birthdays and at Christmas. We also provide for other needs as requested by the child's caseworker, such as camps, field trips, graduation expenses, athletic/musical equipment, and many other incidental needs that may arise. Our stated purpose is to provide opportunities for these children that otherwise might not be possible.

Marion County Public schools provide us with the names of children who need clothing suitable for school wear. This past year we purchased pants, shirts, shoes, socks, belts, and underwear for 200 children. In addition to the needs of the individual children, we place toiletries, underwear, socks, and jogging suits in their schools to be used as the principals, teachers and staff determine needs.

We also serve children in our community by providing scholarships for needy children to attend college. We hope to be able to continue this in the future.
